### **Arrival**


Umpires are expected to book flights to Luxembourg Airport (LUX) or by train to Luxembourg Central Railway Station.

## From the airport to the venue

From the Central Railway Station ("Luxembourg, Gare Centrale") you will take the tram ("T1", direction "Kirchberg, Luxexpo") until the Station "Kirchberg, Coque". See photo below. 


